## AXON

Lake Havasu found the AXON easy to use even in tactical situations because they could start recording with a click of the AXON Com Hub. With built-in signal features, Lake Havasu officers always knew if the AXON is in the recording mode or the off mode. The officers also found that the hardware is simple to understand while giving them powerful tools that they can wear at all times. Also, the dashboard for the AXON Tactical Computer had instinctive controls that everyone at Lake Havasu mastered.

## EVIDENCE.COM

Lake Havasu officers noted that EVIDENCE.COM was intuitive to use and they did not have to be tech savvy to master it. The agency was using EVIDENCE.COM to its full potential with the guidance of TASER by their side within hours.

## Less Confusion
