Dear Mr. Cover:

This refers to your letter of June 2, 1994, with which you provided additional information concerning the dimensions of the production version of Air Taser Model 34000 electronic stun gun. Also provided was information concerning changes to the cassette.

You indicated that the production version is approximately 1 inch longer than the prototype submitted but is slimmer in both width and thickness. You also indicated that the cassette, now called an air cartridge will utilize compressed carbon dioxide gas instead of nitrogen.

The above changes would have no bearing on the previous classification of the Air Taser as not being a firearm. This determination is based on the fact that the device does not utilize the frame or receiver of a firearm, does not expel a projectile by the action of an explosive, and the diameter of the bore(s) is less than one-half inch.
